

## Adult Protective Services (APS), January 1 – December 31, 2004

### Reports of Abuse, Neglect, Self Neglect, Financial Exploitation, or Abandonment

- APS reports are made for vulnerable adults who are living in the community. Reports about alleged abuse or neglect in a boarding home, adult family home, or nursing facility are made to the Complaint Resolution Unit.
- In the table below, column #2 shows the number of APS reports received in that county in 2004. Column #3 shows the number of reports actually investigated by APS staff. Not all reports are investigated; the alleged victim may not meet the definition of a “vulnerable adult,” the report may not meet the definition of abuse or neglect, or another jurisdiction may be responsible for investigation.
- Columns #4-19 break out the type of allegation by report and substantiation.
- Column #20 shows the number of reports where one or more allegations were substantiated. A report or investigation may involve more than one allegation.
- County designates the location of the alleged victim. Approximately 63% of the reported victims are 60 and older; 37% are ages 18-59.
